Activity	Description	
Industry Visits	This activity would allow students to visit workplaces and to experience the types of opportunity available in different sectors. Typically groups would be up to 25 students.	Days
Industry Mentors	Mentors will be linked to specific small groups of students and would typically meet the group 3-5 times per year to provide guidance on routes into industry.	Hours
Industry Workshops	Workshops may take place on site at HTCS or at specialist provision so that students can have hands on experience of activities associated with different industries.	Days
Industry Events	These events tend to be organised by the industry partner and provide a range of experiences for students throughout a day. These events tend to be offered for large groups of students.	Days
Industry Extra	This activity is our extra curricular offer and involves industry support with clubs. The clubs would operate weekly, but industry support would only be required at key stages during a project.	Hours
Industry Placement	Placements will be offered for a small number of students on an individual basis and are designed to be a bespoke version of work experience.	Days
Industry Assembly	Assemblies are an opportunity for industry to speak to groups of students and inspire them towards a career within a given sector whilst also providing guidance on pathways to employment.	Hours
